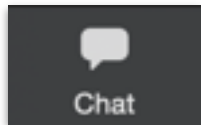

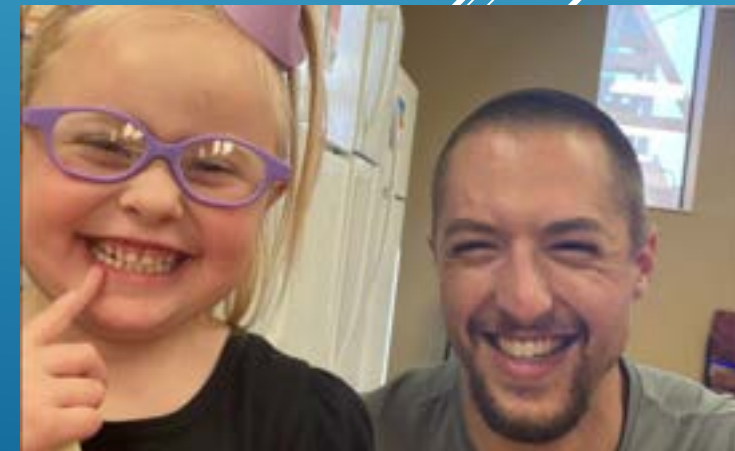

- **Determines need for ongoing care according to level of clinical ability, medical, and psychosocial complexity**
- **Variety of settings: clinic, community, residential**



Social Worker

- Serves as a member of the interdisciplinary team
- Assists with social, emotional and economical concerns of patients/clients/residents and families/caregivers
- Provides crisis intervention and assists families in understanding the implications and complexities of medical situations
- Depending on department may be providing social services for donors and transplant recipients

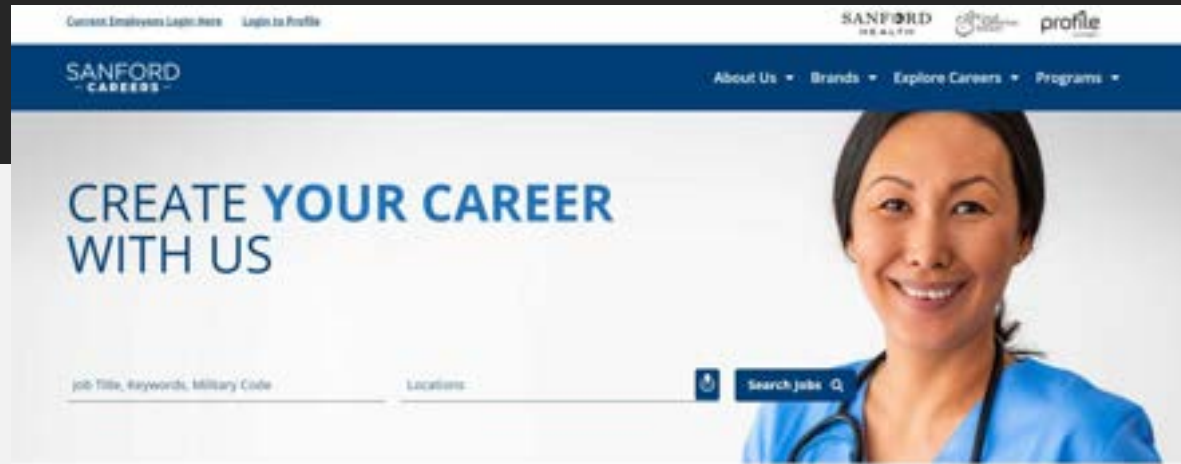
