## **Course Prerequisites for Osteopathic Medicine**

Due to variation in each school's curriculum, the following is merely a guideline of typical requirements. To determine the exact requirements for each program, the student should work with their academic advisor to review each school to which he/she is applying.

To be considered for admission, you must have a B.A. or B.S. from an accredited institution or complete the requirements for a degree before enrollment. Many schools recommend several hours of medical experience, volunteer work, or job shadow experience in health care to be considered for admissions.
