## **Course Prerequisites for Podiatric Medicine**

Due to variation in each school's curriculum, the following is merely a guideline of typical requirements. To determine the exact requirements for each program, the student should work with their academic advisor to review each school to which he/she is applying.

To enter a school or college of podiatric medicine, one must first complete a minimum of three years or 90 semester hours of college credit at an accredited institution. However, over 97% of the students who enter a college of podiatric medicine have a bachelor's degree.
