



This section will give you information on the number of English Learners, those identified with disabilities in Special Education, and those on Free/Reduced Lunch.

More Information

Your mentor teacher will likely not know which students in your class are identified as receiving free/reduced lunch. To determine this number, look at the Percent (22.6% in this example).



Then multiply that % x (no. of students in class). For example, 22.6% (.226) x 24 students = 5.424. Round up to a whole number (6 in this example); then enter this number in the Classroom Demographics section.

When finished, click on 'Close'. This MUST be completed before your instructor can post a grade.

NOTE: If you are placed at a private/non-public school, your school may not be included in the Minnesota Report Card. If this is the case, talk with your mentor teacher to make a reasonable estimate, and enter that information in the Classroom Demographics.
