POLICY

PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS TRANSFERRING FROM WISCONSIN VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL AND ADULT EDUCATIONAL SCHOOLS

1. Students may transfer from schools under the jurisdiction of the Wisconsin Board of Vocational, Technical and Adult Education provided they meet the normal admittance requirements of Southwest Minnesota State University.
2. Credits earned at Madison Area Technical College, Milwaukee Area Technical College and Nicolet Technical Institute (Rhineland) under the *collegiate parallel* program may transfer in the same manner as credits earned at a junior college, college, or university.
3. Credits earned in an associate degree program at a Wisconsin AVTE shall also transfer in the same manner as the collegiate parallel program. The associate degree courses from the Wisconsin AVTE will be evaluated by the Admission's Office as to what courses will partially fulfill the General Studies Requirements. In addition, the courses accepted for transfer credit will be evaluated by the appropriate departments for partial fulfillment of courses in the major area.
4. Students in the diploma program will be awarded a maximum of 32 elective semester credits based on semester hours successfully taken (D grades or below will not transfer.)
5. Total credits accepted may not exceed 64 semester credits.
