**POLICY**

**INSTRUCTOR REPLACEMENT**

If an instructor of a class is replaced after three weeks, each student enrolled in such a class will be given the option to switch to a CR/NC grading system if the class is not already graded on that basis or to drop the class with the tuition refunded for the class and class removed from the transcript. Each student will have five instructional days following formal announcement of the instructor replacement in order to make the choice of one of the two options. If the course is for a major where the CR/NC grading system is not permitted, then that requirement will be waived for the class in which the CR/NC option is chosen because of an instructor replacement. Furthermore, the maximum number of hours permitted to be taken using the CR/NC grading system will be raised by the number of credit hours for which the student selects the CR/NC grading system due to an instructor replacement.
