College Level Examination Program

CLEP exams are a way to place out of college requirements. If you know a lot about a subject area, you can get credit for it without having to take the class.

With CLEP exams, you get the credits, but don't have to pay for the class. There is an \$85 CLEP fee per test payable **in advance** at <https://clep.collegeboard.org/> and a \$20 administration fee per test payable by check, cash, or credit card at check-in on testing day for tests being taken for non-MNSCU schools.

It is the student's responsibility to know which CLEP exam needs to be taken. Certain cutoff scores are required for credit and are determined by each school.

One ID required: passport, driver's license, state or providence ID, military ID, national ID, tribal ID, naturalization card or certificate of citizenship.
