### **Presentation:**

Web mapping ideas for SW Minnesota - Mark Volz

Mark Volz presented Geomoose, a free internet mapping application. He began by showcasing several active Geomoose sites such as The City of St Paul, MN GISmo, Mcleod County Online GIS Mapping, and Lyon County Online Mapping. During that time he showcased some of the features of Geomoose, including but not limited to: printing pdf maps, search for parcels by attribute, identify, pull up pictometry, and measure. The general consensus of the group was that Geomoose could be a desirable program to implement web mapping for our region. The group discussed ideas for consistency in regional web mapping/GIS sites. The discussion was based around the idea of giving users of GIS sites in the region a seamless experience in getting information across political boundaries. The idea of creating a regional site vs creating a common interface was the basis of most of the comments. The group decided to have a group of volunteers to start meeting to move forward in a project to move the region forward in the presentation of regional GIS information.
