Success Spotlight: Technology Resources

In today's digital learning environment, it is essential for students to have access to the software and technology they need to succeed. At Southwest Minnesota State University, we're proud to provide our students with the tools and support necessary for academic success. Our Technology Resource Center (TRC) is fully staffed and ready to assist students with any technology related questions or needs.

On campus, SMSU offers multiple computer labs equipped with both Windows and Mac PCs, as well as printers and scanners for students to use. Our computer labs are conveniently located throughout campus within the academic buildings, the McFarland Library, and in common buildings near the residence halls so students have access to technology without interruption.

All campus computers have up-to-date software, including Microsoft Office applications and Adobe Creative Cloud. Each student also receives 1 GB of personal storage space on their student drive to help organize and store projects and assignments.

Printing is available to all students at no additional cost. Included in their semester tuition, students can print up to \$25 worth of material, equivalent to 500 black and white pages or 100 color pages. Wireless printing is also available throughout campus, allowing students to print directly from their personal devices.

To support collaboration, SMSU offers students AirTame for screen sharing and a free Zoom account for virtual meetings. Webcams and headsets are also available for use as needed.
