I must be dedicated to my field experiences and classroom work and will be held responsible for my actions.

I understand that I must demonstrate my ability to perform the duties required by the state of Minnesota for my licensure area(s).

I understand that I may be removed from the SMSU Teacher Education Program:

- If I do not maintain minimum requirements for academic work in my major;
- If I do not demonstrate professional dispositions required of all teachers and teaching candidates;
- If I do not have successful performance evaluations in all field experiences;
- Upon the recommendation of SMSU's teacher education faculty after a review of my progress in my licensure program.
