K-12 Content test (2 subtests) and Secondary Pedagogy test (2 subtests) prior to licensure. MATH 110 College Algebra or MATH 115 Finite Math are for MTLE prep for Secondary Ed students. If you pass your Math MTLE and have met your math goal with another math course, the requirement of MATH 110 may be waived for admission to the Teacher Education Program. You are responsible to keep informed of any changes in requirements which may affect your academic career.
