The schedule of courses below shows one way to complete the Accounting major, the Liberal Education Program, and graduation requirements in four academic years. Since there are numerous choices for most of the LEP requirements and the Group A/B/C courses, there is some flexibility in how these requirements can be met. Beginning with Intermediate Accounting, ACCT 311, courses are offered only once per year, as detailed in the Accounting Program Course Offerings. Students can, and regularly do, use the elective credits to complete either a minor or a second major.
