Once PELSB receives your application, it will likely take at least 4-6 weeks for your license to be processed. No paper licenses are mailed out. You can use the <u>PELSB License Lookup tool</u> to check the status of your license application.

<sup>\*</sup>If you have courses from other universities that count towards licensure, you will need to request those transcripts, as well. You will include this with your SMSU course equivalency form.
