A student should have a B (3.0) average in all required mathematics courses before being recommended for admission to the Teacher Education Program.

• A student should maintain a B (3.0) average in all required mathematics courses including a minimum of 22 credits completed before being recommended for student teaching.

All courses counting toward the major must be completed with a grade of "C-" or better.
