Portfolio Artifact List

SMSU teacher candidates will develop a professional portfolio in which they will demonstrate the knowledge and skills aligned to their licensure area. The portfolio will be submitted intermittently throughout the program, so candidates can receive timely feedback on their attainment of licensure standards.

Candidates must include two to four artifacts per Standard of Effective Practice (SEP) with complete justifications and reflections to support the selection of the artifact. At least one artifact for each SEP must be from the student teaching semester. Additionally, candidates must include a minimum of 20 artifacts aligned to their content standards, with at least one aligned to each of the standards.

The list below includes the artifacts that will be submitted for specific SMSU courses. If a candidate did not take a course at SMSU, they are encouraged to attach an artifact from another course. These artifacts may come from courses taken at another college or university. Candidates are also encouraged to add additional artifacts to their portfolio.
