After her untimely death in 2001, the SMSU community created a way to honor psychology professor Dr. Cathy Cowan's outstanding service to both the university and the region by designing an award in her name for ***current faculty and staff*** with at least 5 years of service. Nominations for this honor may come from students, faculty, staff, administrators and/or members of the regional community.

Please include the following information:

- Why should the committee consider this nominee?
- What makes this nominee stand out from other possible nominations?
- What service has this nominee given to SMSU that is above and beyond the scope of their position at the university?
- What service outside of SMSU has the nominee participated in that can be termed as "Doing Good for Others"?
- How many people has the nominee's service benefitted?

You may also submit additional letters of support to provide depth to your nomination.
