There is more to it:


- Speaks to our desires & strengths as educators

- Longevity of programs, departments, & disciplines




Why are data and assessment important for equity?

- Help reveals & elucidate disparities in outcomes
- Helps us tell a story about what is happening with our students
- Makes equity gaps visible
- Prompts us to ask "how can we make things better?"
- Gauge efficacy & improvement







On Institution's & Our End

- Disparities in learning outcomes encourages us to ask how our practices, processes, policies, <u>pedagogy & curriculum</u> shape equity gaps?
- Better for learning of some students than others?
- What can we do in the classroom and outside of the classroom?
- Shift away from student deficit approaches


