3. RASL Review Presentations A. Lori Baker B. Lindsay Rohlik	Lori and Michele reported on the Philosophy and Spanish RASLs. Lindsay will report at the next meeting.
	Philosophy RASL is complete. With the upcoming retirement in the department, there are some questions as to how frequently assessments should be done. With the probability that some classes will be taught by adjuncts, their hope is to standardize their documents to keep them consistent from year to year.
	Spanish RASL is also complete (may not have alignment matrix). They have essentially had theirs done since 2013, so it may be time to take another look at it soon, including the timeline. They need new data to establish benchmarks. This is especially important if there are not professional standards for the discipline. There is a sabbatical next year so, like Philosophy, there is a desire to get things into place so there is consistency to data.
