Success Spotlight: Technology Resources

In the new 'norm' of digital learning, it is critical for students to have access to the software and technology needed to complete their work. SMSU is proud to provide our students with the technology needed to be successful in their courses. Our Technology Resource Center (TRC) is fully staffed to help students with all of their technology questions and needs.

On campus, SMSU has multiple computer labs supplied with both Windows and Mac PCs, along with printers and scanners for students to use. Our computer labs are spread out throughout campus within the academic buildings, the McFarland Library, and in commons buildings near the residence halls so students have access to technology without interruptions.

All of the computers on campus have updated software for your student to use including Microsoft Office applications and Adobe Creative Cloud. Students are also provided 1 GB of storage on their student drive so they can keep track of all of their projects and assignments.

Our students also have printing available to them at no additional cost. Included in their semester tuition, students can print up to \$25 of material, which is 500 black & white pages or 100 full-color pages. Wireless printing is available throughout campus as well, so students can print from their personal devices too!

We also provide students with resources for collaboration. SMSU offers students AirTame streaming for screen sharing and a free student Zoom account so they can collaborate with their peers any time. There are also webcams and headsets available for students to use as needed for those virtual group meetings.
