Late yesterday afternoon, Chancellor Devinder Malhotra sent a memo to Presidents regarding staffing continuity of operations/mandatory telework and flexible work options during the COVID-19 outbreak. Until further notice, all college and universities have been directed to take immediate action to implement telework for all employees unless work responsibilities require an employee to be physically present on site.
