Additional Licensure: Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL) Grades K-12

This advising guide is for teacher candidates who already hold a tier 3 or 4 MN professional license. The Standards of effective practice have been met with initial licensure. Instead of a 12-week student teaching placement, there will be a minimum 80-hour practicum after all coursework has been completed.

MTLE tests required for this major: English as a Second Language K-12 Content test (2 subtests) prior to licensure.
