ASSIGNMENTS

Assignments – Assignment list opt-in for learners | Updated 20.19.06

You and your learners may have the option to opt-in to the new Assignment list view. The new Assignments list experience provides an opt-in and opt-out fly-out menu, in which the user can opt-out at any time. When opting out, you may leave feedback regarding the new Assignment list view that is sent directly to D2L developers.

This opt-in feature was available in the January 2019 release (version 10.8.9). For schools you have tried out the new Assignments list, you may continue to opt-in and opt-out of the new Assignments List experience with this feature update.

Welcome to the new assignment list experience! The new experience is turned off. Turning on the new assignment list experience will change your assignment list view. You can return to the old assignment list experience at any time. Turn it on Leave it off




Figure: Opt out to the new Assignments list experience from the assignments tool fly-out menu






Figure: Existing Assignments List view for instructors (opt out view)




Figure: New Assignments list view for instructors (opt in view)






Figure: Existing Assignments list view for learners (opt out view)




Figure: New Assignments list view for learners (opt in view)

CHAT

Chat – Reflects Legal Names | New 20.19.06

If a user's first name or last name is changed, they will now see their first name or last name reflected in the Chat tool the next time the user enters a chat. Previously, the Chat tool would not reflect the user's first name or last name changes after entering a chat. Chat history is static and will contain whatever the user's first name and last name was at the time of entering that chat.



If a user's role has the option to change the Chat alias and an alias was set, that alias name will be displayed in the Chat tool instead of the user's first name and last name.

This feature implements PIE item D5174.




Figure: Now, the Chat reflects updates to a user's first name and last name

CLASS/USER PROGRESS

User Progress – Consistent tracking of Content progress across D2L Brightspace | Updated 20.19.06

Previously, different tools and features within D2L Brightspace used different logic for determining user progress through Content topics. Now, the logic has been consolidated so that it is calculated in the same way across the platform.

Content must meet three criteria to be included in the user progress:

- The learner must have access to the content
- The content must be marked with a completion method of Required Automatic or Required Manual (View knowledge article #1313 Content completion and participation for more information)
- The content is not exempt for that learner
 (View knowledge article #1310 Manage course content for more information)

When content does not meet these conditions, the topics are not included in the calculation of the learner's content progress.

These changes affect the following areas of the D2L Brightspace:

- Class Progress has a new Content Completed indicator column to represent completed content. From the Class
 Progress screen, select the Settings screen. On this screen, you can replace an existing option to add the new
 Content Completion Summary option.
- In Class Progress, the current content-related column has been being renamed from Content to Content Visited.
- The Content sections of the Class/User Progress tool have several changes:
 - The progress on a module now reflects the number of completed and required topics in all levels below the module. Previously, the module progress reflected the number of completed topics immediately inside the module and the number of completed sub-modules. The new progress percentage and number is an actual reflection of how far the learner has progressed through the module.
 - The Topics Visited statistics on the left side of the page now include a denominator. The data represents the
 number of unique topics that the user visited. The denominator indicates the total number of topics that the
 student can access. In addition, the #Visits column is now renamed to Total Visits.
 - In the Content section of the Summary page and in the Content detail page, Visits has been renamed to Completed.






Figure: The Content Completion Summary progress indicator on the Class Progress Settings screen




Figure: The Content Completed and Content Visited indicator columns in Class Progress






Figure: The content module progress is an actual reflection of the learner's progress with the number of completed and required topics in all levels below the module






Figure: The **Topics Visited** statistics denominator indicates the total number of topics that the student can access




Figure: The #Visits column is now renamed to Total Visits

DISCUSSIONS

Discussions – Save feedback in draft state when associated with rubrics | Updated 20.19.06

This feature provides instructors the option to save feedback as a draft on discussions associated with rubrics before publishing it to learners. Now, when instructors add feedback for discussions with rubrics, the **Publish** and **Save Draft** buttons display. Previously, **Save** and **Close** buttons would display. This feature extends the existing **Publish** and **Save Draft** options when grading rubrics in other assessment tools and other discussion screens.

This feature update is specific to the discussion topic's Assess Topic screen. Select **Show All Scores** from the 'View Options' menu, select a rubric link under a student. In the rubric window, the **Save** and **Close** buttons have been replaced by the **Publish** and **Save Draft** buttons.

Note: The **Publish** and **Save Draft** buttons are already available when clicking the **Topic Score** link from the Assess Topic screen. This feature makes the grading rubric experience consistent, regardless of the specific screen or process the instructor uses to grade rubrics.




Figure: Previously, the rubric link on Assess Topic screen displayed Save and Close buttons







Figure: Now, the rubric link on the Assess Topic screen displays Publish and Save Draft buttons

Note: We have identified an issue with the **Grid View** in which the **Publish** and **Save Draft** buttons do not display and clicking **Save** causes an error. We have reported this issue to D2L for further investigating (as of June 12, 2019).

MYDESIRE2LEARN

myDesire2Learn – Self-Registration service migration | Updated 20.19.06

The user registration flow for myDesire2Learn.com will no longer leverage the EduDentity login service. **Current** users of myDesire2Learn.com will experience no change to the login process and no action is required from them. D2L will contact all registered myDesire2Learn users via email with direct notification of this change.

There will be a new user registration workflow introduced with this change that applies only to **future** users of myDesire2Learn.com

Note: D2L's site, <u>myDesire2Learn.com</u> (https://www.mydesire2learn.com/d2l/loginh), is a cloud-hosted ePortfolio site. It allows users the ability to import their D2L Brightspace ePortfolio items from their campus D2L Brightspace site. 


Figure: The 'Create Your Account' registration screen on the myDesire2Learn.com site

QUICK EVAL

Quick Eval – Improvements to Quick Eval list | Updated 20.19.06

To improve the Quick Eval experience, the following updates are now available:



- A Draft icon displays in Quick Eval for discussion posts that have feedback in draft status
- Evaluators only see discussion posts and quiz attempts from learners in sections they are enrolled in. This matches the behavior of assignment submissions.




Figure: Example of a Quick Eval link available on the My Home page navigation bar




Figure: The 'evaluation saved as draft' icon next to a learner's name for a discussion post






Figure: The 'Back to Quick Eval' link after clicking a learner's name in Quick Eval




Figure: Publish button to release graded discussion post to learner

What determines if a course displays in Quick Eval

• Course is **active** and within its start and end date

Note: For other courses, learner submissions need to be evaluated from within the course

An unevaluated learner submission displays if

- Assignments:
 - o Any assignment submission type (except 'Automatically on Evaluation' completion type)
 - o The submission score/feedback is not published (Publish button displays)
- Discussions:
 - o The discussion is associated with a grade item
 - o The post is ungraded (Publish buttons displays)
- Quizzes:
 - o The quiz is not set up for auto-grading
 - o The attempt is ungraded (Graded checkbox is not checked)





An unevaluated learner submission does not display if

- The assignment submission is within a group assignment
- The discussion post is within a group discussion
- The discussion post is in a moderated topic and has not been approved by the evaluator
- The discussion topic has a rubric associated with it but does not have a grade item associated with it
- The quiz is automatically sent to the gradebook but individual questions may need evaluation (such as Written Response type questions)

Quick Eval Limitations

- There is **no special anonymous** evaluation mode for Quick Eval
 - Learner names display (rather than 'anonymous user') for an assignment with 'anonymous marking' and submission score/feedback is not published
 - Learner names display (rather than 'anonymous') for a discussion topic with 'Allow anonymous posts' option, topic is associated with a grade item, and the anonymous post is ungraded
- Quick Eval does not list grade items, SCORM objects and LTI activities (like Bongo video assignments).
- Quick Eval list cannot be filtered by sections; however, an evaluator only sees submissions from the sections they are enrolled in.

When learner submissions are evaluated and published, they no longer show up in the Quick Eval list. An empty Quick Eval list indicates that no learner submissions (that fit the above criteria) are pending evaluation.

QUIZZES

Quizzes – Arithmetic and significant figures questions round up from .5 | Updated 20.19.06

Arithmetic and Significant Figures questions in quizzes now round up from .5 by default. Previously these types of questions were rounded down from .5. **Note**: Past quiz attempt scores **are not** affected by this change.

In arithmetic questions, you can use Answer Precision limits the number of acceptable decimal places allowed in a response. You can require that correct answers contain a specific number of decimal places. When it is enforced as 1, the student's answer with two decimal points is marked as incorrect. Instead, the student must now round **up to .5** to receive credit for the answer precision.

For example, an arithmetic question with the formula 3.41 * {x} would equal 85.25 for the solution. When the 'Answer Precision' is set to 1, it previously rounded down to 85.2 for the solution. Now, the new method will round up to 85.3 for the solution.

* When does the rounding occur?

There is a config variable that the admin would set to select if banker's rounding or regular rounding is used. This is also behind a feature flag, that must be on. These were released for 20.19.06. If the flag and configuration are on, then numeric values should stop rounding using banker's rounding and instead use regular rounding.

* Overall summary to users

The system until now used a banker's rounding rule for arithmetic question types. The system now uses the more standard arithmetic rule when rounding, unless that rule is turned off by administrators.

* Is it display only?

No, but it depends: For example, on the display side, if significant figures are selected and the number is something like 0.0015, it may round to 0.002 for one significant figure, but the database will retain the original number. But it



would display 0.0015 for two significant figures, based on what is asked for. If in an arithmetic question type, elaborate calculation a number has to be rounded, it will be, using the normal arithmetic rule, to about 15 decimal digits of accuracy. Digits after that will be lost and not stored in the database. This is just in the nature of floating point math.

* Is it just going forward from 20.19.06?

The display of numbers in these questions will affect all numbers and questions, as they will display using this new rule.

Data is not modified in older questions. What is there remains untouched. If data is recalculated, it will use the new method.

This feature implements PIE item D1751.




Figure: New config variable, d2l.Tools.Quizzes.RoundingLogicUpdate

Quizzes – New Quiz Builder Experience Preview | New 20.19.06

This feature releases a read-only preview of workflow related to deleting questions, sections, and question pools in the Quiz Authoring (Builder) Experience, which you can enable in the QA environment in a sandbox or non-live courses. D2L does not recommend using this new quiz authoring experience in live production courses in its preview form.

Once this read-only preview feature is turned on at the course level, instructors can then opt in / opt out of the new experience. Once turned on, you can preview the new Quiz Authoring (Builder) Experience by clicking Add/Edit Questions on the quiz Properties tab. The new quiz authoring (builder) experience preview contains the following additions:

- Users can delete questions from a quiz
- Users can delete sections from a quiz
- Users can delete question pools from a quiz

When you opt out of the new Quiz Authoring (Builder) experience, you are prompted and encouraged to leave feedback on the new design.








Figure: Current look of the delete functionality from the Add/Edit questions screen within a quiz




Figure: Current delete confirmation window for questions, sections, question pools




Figure: Delete functionality from Add/Edit questions screen in the new Quiz Authoring (Builder) Experience






Figure: Delete confirmation window for questions, sections, question pools in the new Quiz Authoring (Builder) Experience




Figure: New quiz authoring experience with the option to opt in and opt out




Figure: Feedback screen when opting out of the new Quiz Authoring Experience

RUBRICS

Rubrics – Consistent assessment experience for Discussions | New 20.19.06

When instructors use the rubrics grading experience with Discussions, the following workflows present the same redesigned assessment experience:

- If a rubric is attached to a discussion that is not associated with a grade item
- If a rubric is attached to a discussion and associated with a grade item, but the instructor clicks on the rubric name to assess instead of topic score

Note: This feature update is specific to the discussion topic's Assess Topic screen. Select **Show All Scores** from the 'View Options' menu, and click on a rubric name under a student. The window displays the upgraded Rubric grading experience.

In these workflows, the same design displays for the Rubric assessment screen with the details, score, feedback, post information, and all rubrics available to grade.

Note: This feature makes grading rubrics consistent, regardless of the specific screen or process the instructor uses. This feature is aligned with (although a separate from) the updated Rubrics grading experience, which is currently available in assessment tools, including discussions. The updated Rubrics grading experience is a separate feature functionality.




Figure: The old Rubric design when a discussion is not associated with a grade item






Figure: The revised Rubric design when a discussion is not associated with a grade item




Figure: The updated Rubric grading experience (when feature turned ON) when a discussion is not associated with a grade item






Figure: Upon clicking on a rubric, the old Rubric design when a discussion is associated with a grade item




Figure: Upon clicking on a rubric, the revised Rubric design when a discussion is associated with a grade item






Figure: Upon clicking on a rubric, the updated Rubric grading experience (when feature turned ON) displays when a discussion is associated with a grade item

Rubrics – Updated grading experience for rubrics with learning objectives | New 20.19.06

When an instructor assesses a rubric with associated learning objectives, the updated Rubrics Grading Experience now displays. This new experience displays in all locations where an instructor can assess a rubric with learning objectives, i.e. Competencies, Assignments, Discussions, and Grade Items.



Note: Same as the current behavior, you can view the list of associated learning objectives below the rubric. The pyramid learning objective symbol appears on rows to indicate which criteria the learning objective is aligned to, or with the overall score, if it is aligned to the overall score.




Figure: A discussion topic associated with a learning objective assessed with a rubric








Figure: Previously, the old Rubric design with an associated learning objective




Figure: The revised Rubric design (Publish and Save Draft buttons) with an associated learning objective






Figure: Now, the updated Rubrics grading experience (when feature turned ON) displays for a rubric with an associated learning objective
