1) Click on the Wireless Icon on your Laptop taskbar.



2) From the available Network Connections select the SMSU Network OnRamp.



3) After you have selected the SMSU Network OnRamp, open a new webpage on your browser (For example on Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox), and go to <u>https://onramp.smsu.edu</u>. This will prompt a Welcome message to the SMSU Network, and you will have to agree to the Terms and Conditions, and click Start.
