


Windows Updates


Windows 7 / Windows 10 / Windows 11

1) Windows 7

- a) Go to the *Start* screen (press the *Windows* button on your keyboard or drag your mouse to the lower left corner of your screen and click on the *Windows icon*), and type *Windows Update* in the Search bar. When it pops up in the program list, click on it.






- a) Once on the Windows Update screen, click on *Check for updates*. If there are any updates available for your computer, click on *Install Updates*.



2) Windows 10

- a) Go to the Start screen and click on *Settings* (the gear icon above the power icon on the left), then click on *Update & Security*.






b) Once on the Windows Update screen, click on *Check for updates*. If there are any updates available for your computer, click on *Install Updates*.

3) After the updates install, reboot your machine and check again for updates in case there might be new ones.


4) If an update fails, restart your computer and try again to update. Try installing one update at a time instead of multiple together so you can see which one fails. If it does not work, do not hesitate to contact the Technology Resource Center for assistance.

3) Windows 11

a Click on the windows icon on your keyboard or find the windows icon in your taskbar if your keyboard doesn't have the windows icon, after clicking the windows icon type *Settings* in the search bar.



b. Once you click on settings scroll down until you see the Windows Update screen.



C. Once on the Windows Update screen, click on *Check for updates*. If there are any updates available for your computer, click on *Install Updates*.
