“What’s New in GeoMoose?”

GeoMoose is a Web client JavaScript framework for displaying GIS data. The GeoMoose project is client-side code that uses a variety of JavaScript, XML, and DHTML technologies to interface with other web-clients. The primary target of Moose is for integration with the University of Minnesota's MapServer.

The developers have been busy working on a new version of GeoMoose, which is going to be released as GeoMoose 2.0. This presentation will discuss changes and demonstrate the new features. New features include integration with OpenLayers, support for tiled images and a data editor.
